If a student fails to follow Central Youth Camp guidelines and rules, they will be asked to leave the camp without refund. It will be the parent/guardian's responsibility to come pick up the student from Camp Chautauqua without refund.

## RULES & GUIDELINES

- No alcohol, tobacco (including electronic cigarettes –vape pens, etc.), weapons, drugs, or explosives of any kind. If found, all items will be confiscated and the parent/guardian will be contacted immediately for pick up without refund.
- If a student is caught looking at porn/inappropriate content on their cell phone, iPad, iPod, tablet, or any other device, parents will be immediately contacted for pick up without refund.
- Absolutely NO acts of vandalism on campus grounds. Students will be responsible for the cost of all damages.
- Students are expected to treat everyone with respect and kindness, including students, leaders, staff, and volunteers. Bullying, harassment, fighting, etc will not be tolerated and the parent/guardian will be immediately contacted for pick up without refund.
- Central Youth Camp/7 Hills Church is not responsible for any property lost, stolen, or damaged while on Camp Chautauqua campus.
- All students must travel in groups of 3 or more at all times during permitted hours (i.e. Rec time and After parties). Students must remain with their leader and group during services, meals, and while in cabins.
- Everyone must attend all worship and rec time experiences. Students will not be permitted to hang out in their cabin during the worship or rec time experiences.
- All students should be inside their rooms by 11:30p. Students are NOT permitted out of their cabins after 11:30p. Group leaders will be rooming in the cabins and there will be chaperones patrolling the campus.
- No males in female rooms/cabins at any time. No females in male rooms/cabins at any time. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- Students are not permitted to enter an out of bounds area. Out of bounds areas will be clearly defined to all students before the beginning of the first night session on Tuesday.
- Students must travel on common walking paths.
- Students are NOT permitted to walk on campus after dark without a leader.

## **CABIN GUIDELINES**

- No sharing beds at any time (including sitting on the same bed)
- No showering together
- Everyone must be clothed
- No changing in front of others
- Follow cleaning list on final morning

## **MODESTY STANDARDS**
